22,292 FAMILY EMERGENCY KITS

Family Emergency Kits include a weeks' worth of food for a family of five, protective items like hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes, toys and educational items and other essentials.



319,627 PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are critical supplies distributed to first responders such as medical centers, hospitals and more with items such as face masks, gloves, boot covers, hand sanitizer and more.



293,366 FRESH FOOD BOXES

World Vision partners with national and local food distributors to deliver fresh produce, meat or dairy at a time when families need them the most.

CEO/PRESIDENT LORI MCAFEE – WINGS AS EAGLES MINISTRIES

Tucked in the northern plains of the US is Wings As Eagles Ministries, an evangelical relief organization to Native American youth and families. They have served



more than 2,200 families with Fresh Food Boxes. Already challenged with poverty, COVID-19 has added additional needs to Native American communities in this region.

"[The pandemic] has made it close to impossible for these people to eat. The produce that's been coming in—I am amazed," says President and CEO, Lori McAfee.

"The native people are the least of the

least. The native children are the least of the least. They're a humble people. If Jesus were here, and he were walking the earth, he would be serving the least of these my brethren. They're [World Vision] lifting up smaller ministries in communities that are forgotten."

Lori said, "From Northern Arapahoe, I got a message. They said, 'We love you. You brought us so much help in this difficult time.'"
